Sunday we commemorate the lives of Isaurus and His companions in Athens. They were martyrs during the reign of Numerian (283-284) who refused to renounce their faith.

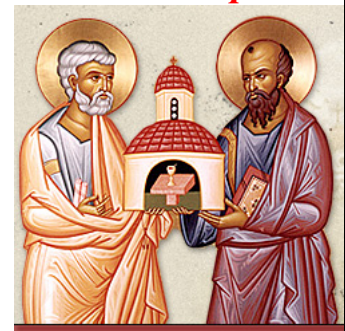
